## NOTIFICATION OF THE MINISTRY OF PUBLIC HEALTH RE: PROHIBITED DISEASES FOR PERMISSION GRANTEES AND PERSONS ON DUTY IN RELATION TO HERBAL PRODUCTS,

B.E. 2563 (2020)\*

By virtue of the provisions of section 5 paragraph one and section 6 (14) of the Herbal Products Act, B.E. 2562 (2019), the Minister of Public Health, with the recommendation of the Herbal Product Committee at the meeting no. 6/2563 on 30<sup>th</sup> October B.E. 2563 (2020), hereby issues the Notification as follows:

**Clause 1.** This Notification shall come into force as from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.

**Clause 2.** No person with the following diseases shall be allowed to be a permission grantee or a person on duty in relation to the manufacturing, importation or sale of a herbal product:

- (1) leprosy;
- (2) tuberculosis at dangerous stage;
- (3) elephantiasis;
- (4) narcotic addiction:
- (5) alcoholism.
