the Food Act B.E. 2522 (1979), the Minister of Public Health by recommendation of the Food

Committee, hereby issues a notification as follows;

Clause 1 Shall be repealed wording in (9) of Clause 10 of the notification of the

Ministry of Public Health No.293 B.E. 2548 (2005), Re: Food Supplements dated 15<sup>th</sup> Decemberr

B.E. 2548 (2005) and shall be replaced with the following text:

"(9) Clear wordings state that "should regularly eat different varieties of

full 5 categories of food, in an appropriate proportion" and with bold letter which colour of the

letters contrast with background of frame of wording state that "No effect for prevention or cure

diseases"

Clause 2 Producers, importers of Food supplement, whose permission for Label

issued prior to this notification come into force, if details do not follow this notification shall be

amended to comply with this notification, and the remaining labels are allowed to be used but

not exceeding to one year after this notification come into force.

Clause 3 This notification shall come into force as from the day following date of its

publication in the Government Gazette.
